

- IN 1913, NORTH CAROLINA BEGAN COLLECTING RECORDS ON ALL BIRTHS AND ALL DEATHS.
- BY 1949, ALL COUNTIES IN NORTH CAROLINA HAD ESTABLISHED LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS.
- BETWEEN 1899 AND 1979, NORTH CAROLINA PUBLIC HEALTH WAS CREATED THROUGH ADMINISTRATION OF VACCINES, MONITORING THE HEALTH OF COMMUNITIES AND EPIDEMIOLOGY.
- LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS CONTINUE TO GROW AND DEAL WITH EMERGING ISSUES SUCH AS EBOLA.
