

FINDING PEOPLE

USPS http://www.usps.com/

The post office site is useful to determine the county of residence if a street address is provided.

Place your cursor on "Send Mail" on the blue toolbar, then select "Look Up Zip Code" from the drop down box. Enter the street address and city only and click on "Find." The address should be displayed including the zip code. Click on "Show Mailing Industry Details" and the county will be displayed.

If the system is unable to find the address, a message in red will be displayed. In some instances, the individual has provided the name of the area where he/she lives instead of the actual name of the city. If you have the zip code, click on "Cities by Zip Code" and enter it. If the zip code is correct, the correct name of the city should be displayed. If you search for the address again with the correct city name it is often found.

Department of Corrections (DOC)

If a person is an inmate in a state prison, his/her current location and location history can be found on the N.C. DOC web site.

To use this function, go to the N.C. Department of Corrections home page. Place your cursor on "Offender Information" located under the star in the N.C. flag. Click on "Public Offender Search." In the screen that appears, enter the information requested for the person you are looking for and click on "search." The more information you enter, the fewer names will be returned with the search. If the name you are looking for appears, click on the blue highlighted DOC number on the left and their file will open. Be sure to scroll down to see all available information. Typically the file shows the county of conviction, admitting location and current location. The file also displays the dates at those locations and projected release dates.

North Carolina Immunization Registry (NCIR)

This site is useful for obtaining vaccination histories as well as phone numbers and addresses. If you are not a NCIR user please contact your local Immunization Coordinator to discuss obtaining READ ONLY access.

FINDING PROVIDERS

NC Board of Medicine

The NC Board of Medicine website is useful when searching for a provider who practices in North Carolina.

In the green Quick Links block located on the right hand side of the page, click on "Look up a Licensee." Follow instructions for searching. Once you have located the provider, click on their blue highlighted name to display the License Information page with several tabs for different categories of information. The Practice Information tab displays the currently listed address and telephone number of the providers practice. The Licensee General Information tab lists any hospital admitting privileges and physician assistants or nurse practitioners that the physician may supervise. There is also a link on the search screen to the N.C. Board of Nursing site where you can search for nurse practioners and the name and address of their practices.
