

North Carolina Electronic Disease Surveillance System (NC EDSS) Training

In this two-day classroom training, participants learn how to enter Communicable Disease and Sexually Transmitted Disease data into NC EDSS and how to report it to the N.C. Division of Public Health. Usefulness of accurate and timely reporting is discussed as it relates to meaningful surveillance data. This class is required for all NC EDSS users, including those who will use the system for tuberculosis control. The training is suitable for clerical, laboratory, and nursing staff.
