

# Recognize the Signs of Carbon Monoxide (CO) Poisoning at Your Worksite!

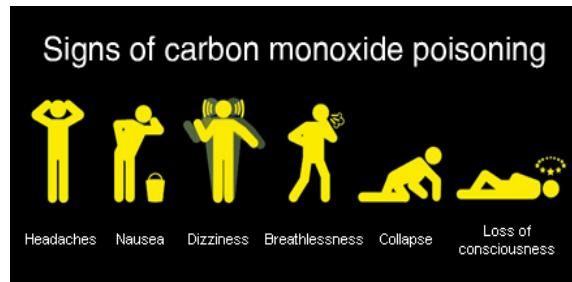

- 1) **Immediately** turn off equipment (if possible). Go outdoors or to a place with **clean air**, if you feel you may have **any signs of CO poisoning!**
- 2) Call 911 **immediately!**
- 3) **Do NOT** drive a motor vehicle.
- 4) **Stay away** from the work area until it is determined to be safe.
- 5) **Use** less hazardous tools (electric or battery-powered) whenever possible.
