



This deposit is located near the crest of a prominent ridge, 1.0 mile northwest of Norton. The deposit can be reached by traveling on SR 1149 for 1.8 miles northwest of Norton. Turn south onto a farm road that leads to a farmhouse. The Bryson mine is about 700 feet south of the farmhouse in a small gap at the northwest edge of the ridge. The Manus mine is about 1000 feet southwest of the Bryson mine on the south slope of the same ridge.
