- Offered free blood sugar checks in bathroom

 Nurse at pediatric clinic stuck herself while trying to recap a needle used to administer
 TdaP to an 11 year-old patient

- City sanitation worker was stuck with a needle while removing trash bag from a private home
- Needle "had blood on it"
