

## Quick Reference: Closing Out a Contact Monitoring Event (ME)

			<i><b>ACTION:</b> Relevant information supporting exemption (e.g., previous COVID diagnosis info documented in Timeline/Activities note, Vaccination Type/Date fields, etc.) completed on monitoring event</i>	
<b>Contact concludes monitoring without testing positive for COVID-19</b>	Fully Complete	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Contact does not test positive for COVID-19</li> <li>Contact completes at least initial monitoring assessment</li> <li>Contact completes at least one monitoring assessment on the end of quarantine date or within the following 48 hours</li> </ul>	No	Monitoring Ended
	Partially Complete	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Contact does not test positive for COVID-19</li> <li>Contact completes at least initial monitoring assessment</li> <li>May include contacts who opt out midway</li> </ul>	No	Monitoring Ended
<b>Contact becomes a case</b>	Contact Tested Positive During Monitoring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Contact tests positive for COVID-19 during the monitoring period and becomes a case patient</li> </ul>	No	Monitoring Ended
		<i><b>NOTE ON CASE PATIENTS:</b> This FMO is specifically to be used for someone labeled as a <u>contact</u> who tests positive. If you are working on an ME labeled as a case, you may use any applicable FMO to describe their monitoring outcome.</i>		<i><b>ACTION:</b> Testing info and any other local requirements complete <a href="#">per job aid</a></i>
<b>Contact opts out of monitoring</b>	Refused	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Contact explicitly declines to participate in monitoring (opts out) at the beginning, which includes opting out through digital notification or acknowledging a notification but not completing any assessments</li> <li>No assessments completed</li> </ul>	No	Opted Out – All Monitoring
<b>Contact does not respond to a digital notification</b>	Notification – No Response	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Contact is sent a digital exposure notification through text (with status of “Sent” or “Delivered”) or email but contact does not acknowledge the notification or complete an assessment</li> </ul>	No	Monitoring Ended
<b>Contact is unreachable</b>	Never Reached	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Contact has never been reached because no attempts to reach contact were made or attempts to reach contact were unsuccessful (per standards determined by LHD) and therefore was not informed of exposure</li> </ul>	No	Monitoring Ended
<b>Contact will be monitored outside CCTO</b>	Monitored in Other System	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Contact will not be monitored within CCTO <i>because they are being monitored within a different system</i> (e.g., by a military organization, prison, or jail)</li> </ul>	No	Monitoring Ended
<b>Contact is a duplicate</b>	Is Duplicate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Contact is a duplicate of another active ME, and any relevant information from this ME has been transferred onto kept ME <a href="#">per job aid</a></li> </ul>	No	Monitoring Ended
			<i><b>ACTION:</b> Any new information transferred onto kept monitoring event <a href="#">per job aid</a></i>	
<b>Other FMOs do not apply</b>	Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Contact cannot be described by any other FMO (e.g., is deceased)</li> </ul>	No	Monitoring Ended
