North Carolina has **AERIAL PESTICIDE APPLICATOR RECIPROCAL** agreements with the states of GEORGIA, SOUTH CAROLINA and MISSISSIPPI in the subclass of public health only. This reciprocity is granted only upon the declaration of a public health emergency by an appropriate North Carolina state or local official. Reciprocity is only granted to individuals who are residents of a state other than North Carolina. Once you become a resident of North Carolina, reciprocity is no longer an option and therefore you must take the appropriate North Carolina exam(s) to become certified and licensed.
